Selection criteria:	<p>Applicants will be assessed according to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Academic achievement, as evidenced by their academic record, • A written recommendation by a university reference, • A written statement of no more than 500 words indicating: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ the benefit they will obtain from the scholarship, ○ a genuine desire to work in the mining and resources industry, and ○ any other information the applicant considers relevant to their application.
Selection process:	<p>Potential recipients will be identified by either SRK (US) practice leaders or through partnerships with local universities. The scholarship panel may interview short-listed applicants.</p> <p>The successful applicant(s) will be notified by SRK (US) by the end of August, 2015. The selection decision is at the complete discretion of the SRK (US) scholarship panel, and while the panel may provide reasons for an unsuccessful application, it is under no obligation to do so.</p>
Terms and conditions:	<p>The successful applicant(s) will be asked to sign a contract containing the terms of the scholarship. Previous scholarship recipients and SRK employee family members are not eligible for the program.</p>
